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AIDN Young Achiever Award

The Australian Industry & Defence Network (AIDN) invites you to demonstrate your achievements as a young professional by entering the AIDN-ACT Young Achiever Award (YAA) 2010.

Driven and talented young people are the key to the future of the defence industry. In order to recognise individuals who may be future industry leaders, AIDN has created the AIDN Young Achiever Award.

WHO CAN ENTER THE AWARD?

The Award is open to all members of Defence Industry aged 30 years and under (entrants must be under 30 years of age on 1 January 2011). You do not have to be a member of AIDN to enter but you must be nominated by a member of AIDN.

WHY SHOULD I ENTER?

Winning the AIDN-ACT Young Achiever Award recognises your efforts, and demonstrates your achievements and your potential to your colleagues, clients and future employers. It will also entitle you to participate in the AIDN National Young Achiever Award.

HOW DO I ENTER?

Please read carefully through the entry form. Once you have completed all of the entry requirements, return your entry form and attachments to the Australian Industry & Defence Network Office for judging AIDN-ACT PO Box 192, Deakin West, ACT 2600 or mail@aidn.com.au.

The closing date for entries is close of business 10 December 2010.

ENTRIES

The purpose of your entry is to tell the judges about your various achievements and to convince them that you are a young professional who has demonstrated talent, leadership skills and professionalism in your career and will continue to do so in the future.

JUDGING

Your entry will be judged by a panel of distinguished professionals associated with the defence industry in the ACT.

Up to three applicants will be short listed as finalists for the AIDN-ACT Young Achiever award, with the winner to be announced in Canberra.

WHAT HAPPENS IF I WIN?

The AIDN-ACT finalists will each be presented with a plaque, and the winner of the AIDN-ACT Young Achiever Award will be presented with her/his plaque and be eligible to enter the AIDN National YAA. These awards will be presented at a function in Canberra.

The recipient of the Young Achiever Award may be asked to participate in relevant activities organised by AIDN-ACT to address members at times through the year. In order to be eligible for the award, the finalists must attend this Function.

AIDN National Young Achiever Award

The winner of the AIDN-ACT YAA will then go on to be judged for the AIDN National Young Achiever Award which will be presented at the ADM Defence Summit Awards Function in February 2011 (date and venue to be advised). In order to be eligible for the award, the finalists must attend this Function. ***Companies would be required to cover the travelling costs of their Young Achiever attending the ADM Special Awards function.***

What Happens if I Win the AIDN National YAA?

The AIDN National finalists will each be presented with a complimentary pass to the next Defence+Industry conference. The winner of the AIDN National Young Achiever Award will be presented with her/his plaque and a complimentary pass to the next Defence+Industry conference. In addition, the national winner will also receive, through the support of the Commercial Division of DMO, a place on the next Defence Industry Study Course (DISC). The AIDN YAA will be presented at the ADM Special Awards function in February 2011.

Have you demonstrated significant achievements for your age? Are you further ahead than you would have expected to progress by this age? Does the career you have had so far reflect the goals that you set yourself in the first selection criteria?*





4. How do you feel you have contributed to the defence industry profession and how do you intend to continue doing so? Provide examples to support your statements.

HINT: Have you undertaken any activities with professional bodies like AIDN-ACT? Have you undertaken any research work that may have contributed to the development of the profession? Have you used your initiative to encourage new or more efficient ways of doing things in your workplace?

5. What has been the most challenging project you have undertaken to date and how did you face the challenges presented?

HINT: This is not exclusive to defence related projects. Research or other projects are applicable. What made this project so significant and what innovations did you contribute to solve the problems?

6. What key issues do you think will affect the defence industry profession in the coming decade and how do you think these should be approached?

HINT: Have you researched these issues? What has led you to the conclusion that they will be important?
